Baby seals know their mothers. Mother seals know their babies. Now Baby Seal had found his mother.

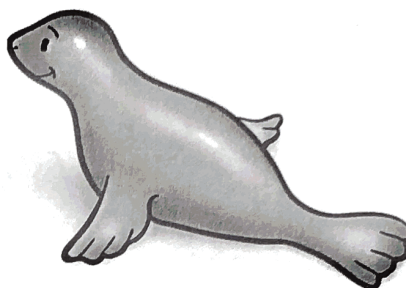

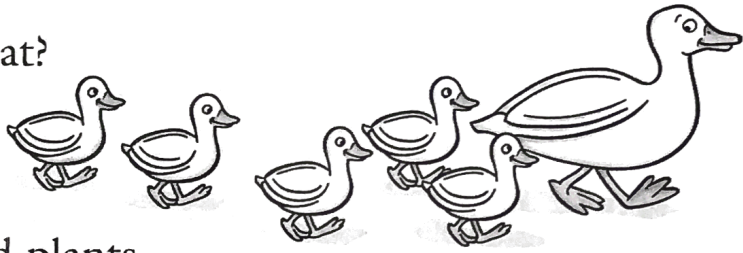

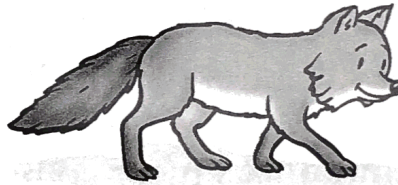
