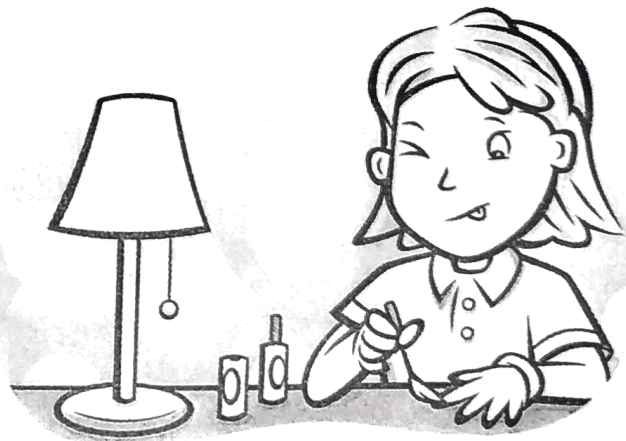
1. Jack turned on the water. He was going to wash the dishes. Jack started talking to his friend. What happened next?

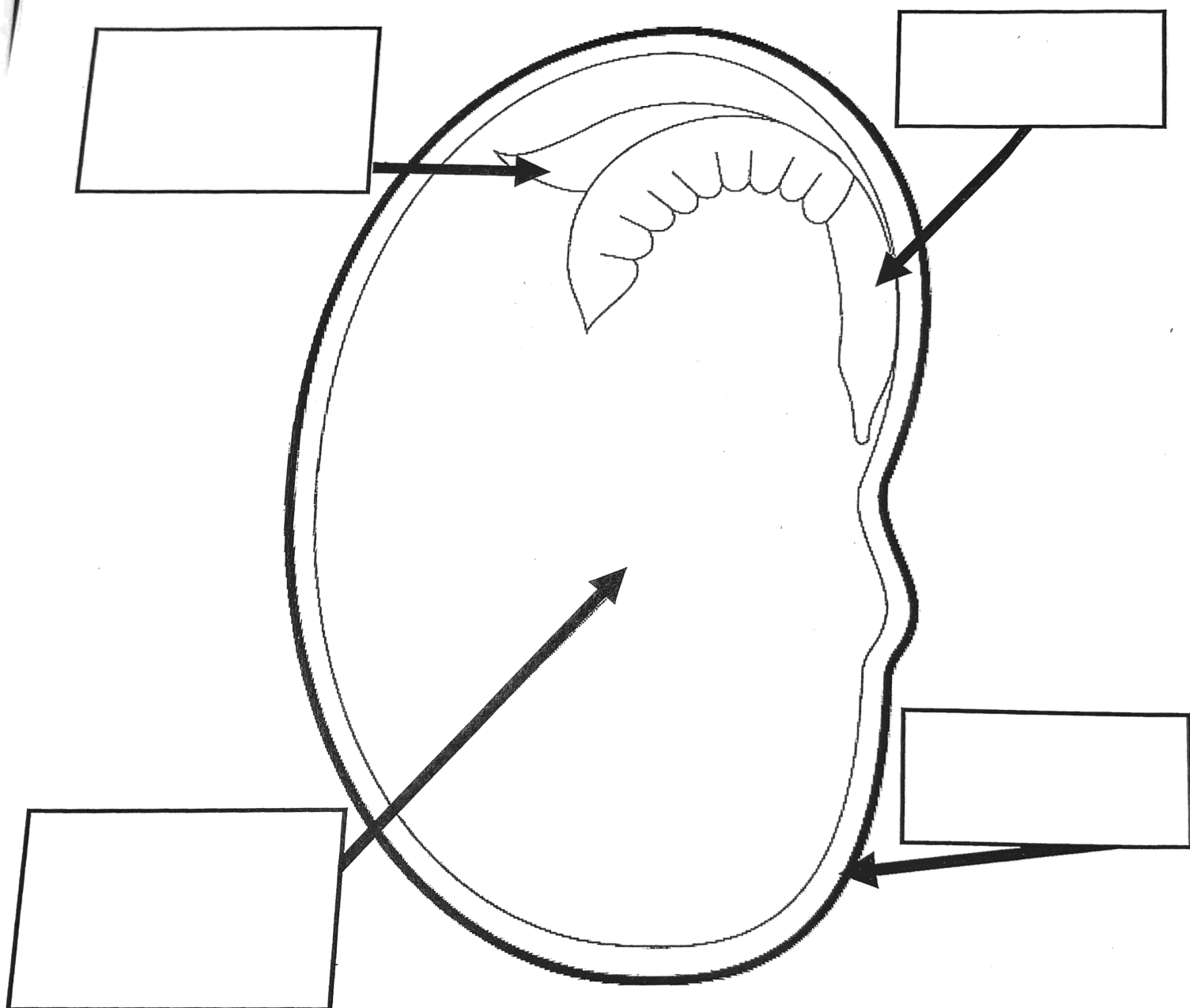
